Year 2 – Algorithms

Year 2 have been learning about algorithms and have been writing these to program bee-bots. This week, they designed their own program map and tested this out.

Year 5 science day

On Wednesday 3rd July Year 5 visited Moulton Secondary School to take part in a science day. The children participated in three science lessons where they had the opportunity to carry out some fascinating experiments. The children investigated a variety of household chemicals, such as lemon juice, washing powder and milk and tested them to discover whether they were acid or alkali. In another lesson, the children made balloon-powered rockets and then tested them out too see how far they would travel. In the third lesson, the children mixed compost, seeds, clay powder and water to create seed bombs and learnt how to nurture their seed bombs at home.

The Year 5 team were all really impressed with the engagement that the whole year group showed in their sessions. The children shared their ideas, cooperated with each other and made sure they were showing our school values at all times. Great job Year 5!
