Over the past two weeks in Art, we have explored the vibrant world of contemporary realism by creating Koi fish art inspired by the stunning work of Terry Gilecki, who is known for his lifelike underwater perspectives and reflections. The children studied his use of colour, light and texture, experimenting with techniques like layering salt and oil in paint to bring depth and realism to their own creations. The results have been truly impressive - each child produced a beautiful, unique





piece that captures the calm elegance of Koi ponds while showcasing their own creativity and attention to detail. We are so proud of the dedication and artistry they have shown with this unit of work!

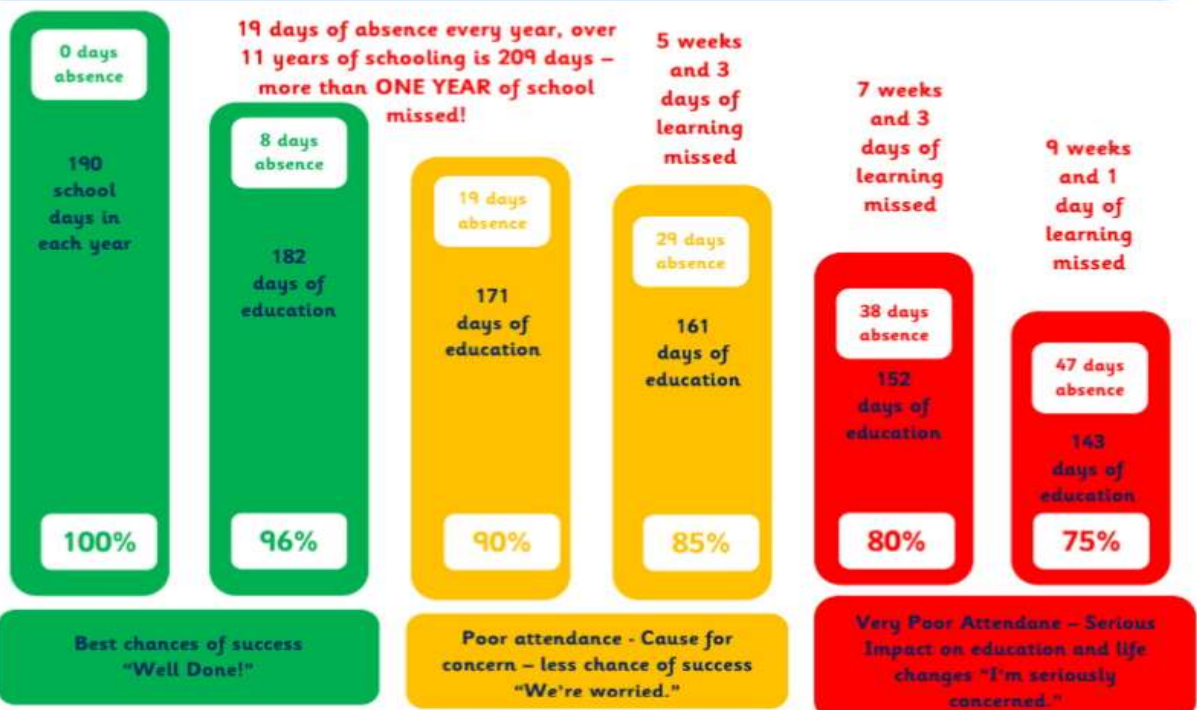


Every School Day Counts! Good Attendance Means... being in school at least 96% of the time. This means 8 days off!
