Science Week

What a fun week we have had celebrating Science Week 2024! Every class delved into a variety of science investigations causing an outbreak of fun all over school.

We had:

- -Reception investigating how plants grow and growing their beanstalks to continue exploring plants.
- -Year 1 investigating whether they could work out whose poo it was they were looking at by the clues left behind.
- -Year 2 testing materials and their properties to see how they bend, twist and squash.
- -Year 3 exploring how light affected the colours we could see.
- -Year 4 measuring which type of chocolate melted the quickest and why.





-Year 5 exploring space and the movements of the Earth and the moon. Year 5 also had the opportunity to spend some time exploring our Solar System inside an inflatable planetarium. The children saw close-up views of the other planets in our Solar System and learnt why some planets are rocky, some are gaseous and some are ice.

-Year 6 sending secret messages in Morse code after making working circuits.




Year 2

The children have been incredibly creative and have challenged themselves to use ambitious vocabulary. Well done Year 2 - we are so impressed with how hard you

Year 6

Year 6 have been having a de'light'ful week, learning about and exploring electrical circuits. We have been testing insulators and conductors, exploring what happens when additional components are added into a simple circuit and have discussed how a battery works. As part of our science week investigation, the children applied their knowledge from our WWII learning to their science explorations by decoding and delivering messages in Morse Code. The children designed their own circuits, experimented with the best way to send their messages and thoroughly enjoyed their 'old fashioned' communication.
