Year 3 have jumped right back into their learning with some practical lessons. In Maths, the children have been thinking



BIG by understanding what it actually means to make something 10 times bigger, or scaling by ten as it is known. The children are learning that it isn't quite as simple as 'just adding a 0'. They used chalk to make objects ten times bigger on the playgrounds, then they used dienes and place value sliders to consider this with numbers. They



have even used this information to be able to consider what it means to make a number 10 times smaller!
