**Year 2**



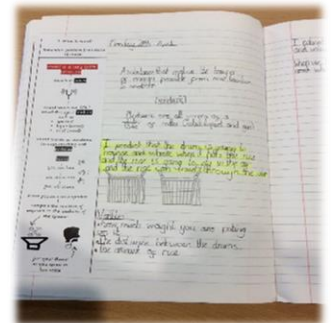
Year 2 have been working really hard in their maths lessons this week. They have been deepening their understanding of fractions and learning how to identify a half, third and quarter of different 2D shapes. The children have also been using Cuisenaire rods to support their understanding of equivalent amounts and how each part of the whole must be divided equally. They have then used this knowledge to help them find two and three quarters of an amount.

We have been so impressed with how resilient and hardworking the children have been this week. Well done Year 2!



**Year 4**

This week we have been exploring sound in our science learning. We have been looking at how sound travels through mediums by vibration. The children explored this by using two cups attached together by string to see if they could use this as a 'telephone' – which the children found very surprising and impressive that they could hear each other due to the sound travelling through the string by vibrations! We also held an experiment to show sound travelling by having two drums with rice on one of them and watching the rice vibrate and bounce as we hit the other drum!
