What will my child receive?



Opportunities to before and after school extra curricular clubs (one club fully funded).



Children in KS2 will have the opportunity to learn an instrument (Funded up to the value of £74 per term).



Access to quality interventions across the year. As well as emotional and well being support.



Access to 1:1 or small group tuition (if needed).

What is the Pupil Premium Grant?

The Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) is an additional funding to support schools to ensure that children from lower income and other disadvantaged backgrounds have the same opportunities as their peers and that they attain well too.

If a child has been eligible for free school meals (FSM) at any point over the past 6 years or has been continuously looked after for at least 6 months (LAC), the school receives an amount per child within their budget.

What can we offer at Moulton Primary School?

At Moulton Primary, we ensure all children, regardless of their background, are able to access quality first teaching, high quality interventions and support across all areas of school life, making progress in line with their peers. At Moulton we actively promote equality of opportunity for all staff, children and families enabling all to achieve well.

What impact will it have on my child?

If your child is in receipt of PPG, we will ensure that they receive their full entitlement and that it has a positive impact on all areas of the education. For example, when a trip is planned, parents/carers of children eligible of PPG will only need to sign the permission slip. You will not be asked for any money. Similarly, if your child plays an instrument or attends a club we are able to meet the cost of £74 per term for music tuition and will be able to fully fund the cost of one extra curricular activity.

How do I know if I am eligible for this?
