

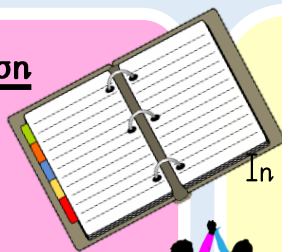
Year 4 Knowledge Map - Term 3

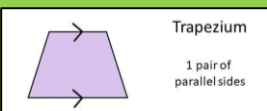


PE

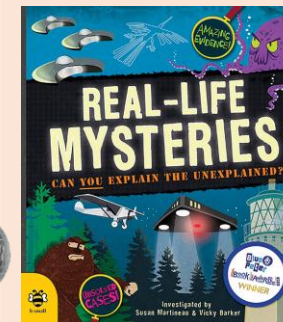

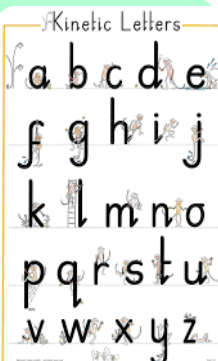

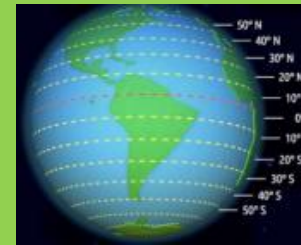
French

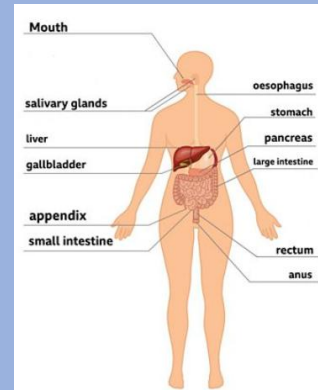


Religious Education
