



In our reading and writing sessions this term we will be focusing on using the following fiction books and looking at list poems.








Phonics

One more than two is three.



Reading


During the first few weeks of term the children will be assessed on their phonics sounds and reading fluency. Eventually, they will have guided reading lessons in class and will take the book home every Friday. More information to follow shortly.

<u>History</u>

In history, we will be deepening our understanding of historical words such as here, now, then, yesterday, last week, last year, years ago and a long time ago and how they can be used to describe the passing of time.

We will sequence words such as first, next, finally, then and after that, to order information chronologically. We will start by looking at how the children have changed since they were born and the stages from baby, toddler to school

We will look at and compare how the children's life has changed and begin to look at events beyond children's living memory and see how different life was and what changes there have been.



This will be explored under the theming of 'Under the Sea' whereby we will investigate the sounds that are created underwater.



Science

In science this term, we will be learning about the four seasons Autumn, Winter, Spring and Summer.

We will be learning about seasonal changes and exploring the school grounds to observe any signs of change in the season. We will discover what the weather is like in in each of the different seasons.












We will also be discovering how day turns into night!

We will end Science this half term looking at Plants.


The children will learn how to identify and name common wild and garden plants, understand the difference between deciduous and evergreen trees and describe the structure of basic plants.
