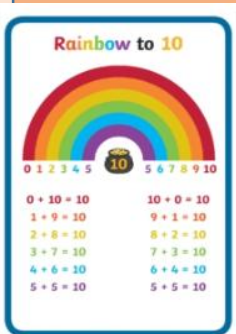


# Year 2 Knowledge Map Term 2

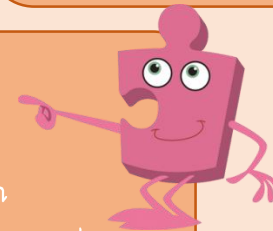
## History
