









Reading


Remember to use Spelling Shed at home too, to practice our weekly spelling words that we will be learning in class.



Science

As part of our science lessons, we will be learning about properties and changes of materials. Our work will include identifying the properties of different materials and understanding the difference between a mixture and a solution. We will investigate different methods for separating materials from mixtures and solutions. We will also learn more about reversible and irreversible changes.

In geography we will be exploring world countries and biomes. We will be investigating where some of the major countries and cities of the world can be found. We will learn that the world's environmental regions are called biomes and how these change across the world. We will focus in more detail on Europe, North America and South America and contrast their physical and human features.

History

During our history unit on the Ancient Greeks we will be learning about Greek life and achievements and thinking about their influence on Europe and the American continents. We will investigate the beliefs of the Greek people, read some Greek myths and fables and explore the differences between Athens and Sparta. We will learn about some important Greek battles and explore the beginning of the Olympic Games.

In art we will master a new technique called subtractive drawing and look at the work of Hundertwasser. We will use lines, spirals, bright colours and overlaying to create abstract

In music we will be learning to sing with accuracy, fluency, control and expression. We will be learning a song called 'Gift of the Nile' which takes its inspiration from the Ancient Egyptians. We will also learn the accompaniment on glockenspiels.
