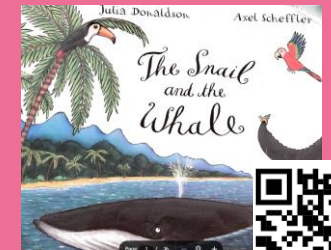
We will start the half term by exploring Joseph Coelho, who is a British poet and children's book author who was elected Children's Laureate in 2022.

Maths

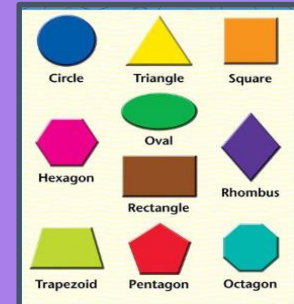

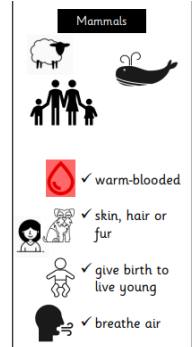
Science

We will identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.

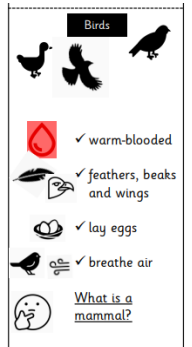


We will learn about animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
