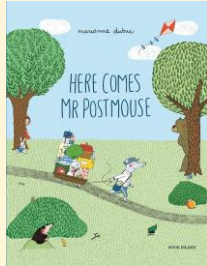
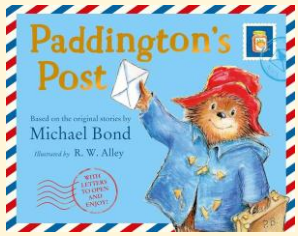


Year 1 Knowledge Map - Term 5

We are looking at two texts this half term which are all about letters! The first is Paddington's Post and the second is Here Comes Mr Postmouse!



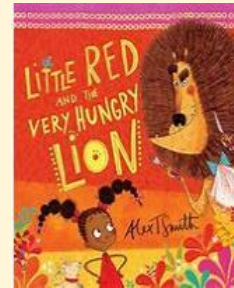
We will explore writing our own letters and postcards to explain to our readers lots of different things we have been up to!

Maths

This term in maths we will be learning more about division and sharing using concrete resources and drawing arrays.

Four children share two packets of 10 grapes equally. How many do they get each?

We will also be learning to count to and across 100. The children will be learning to count forwards and backwards from any given number. They will learn to read and write numbers up to 100.

Computing

This unit introduces children to on-screen programming through ScratchJr. Children will explore the way a project looks by investigating sprites and backgrounds. They will use programming blocks to use, modify, and create programs. The children will also be introduced to the early stages of program design through the introduction of algorithms.

This term we be learning how to identify high and low notes and to compose a simple tune. We will be investigating how tempo changes and helps to tell a story and make music more exciting.

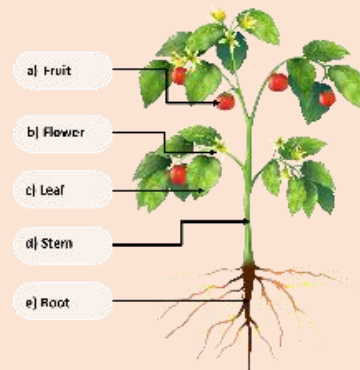


Science

We will reactivate some of our previous learning from throughout the year. We will revisit some key themes including: seasonal change, animals, humans and plants.

Sticky Knowledge:
