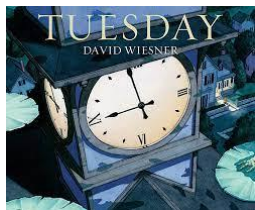


Year 3 Knowledge Map

English

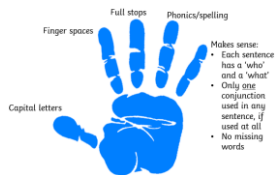
We will be focussing on story writing in our first term. What do you think makes a good story?

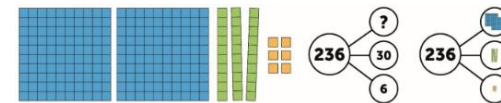

We will also be working hard to quicken our recall of times tables facts. Have you been a Rock Star recently?



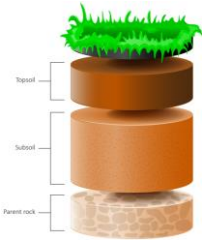

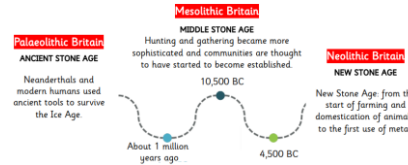

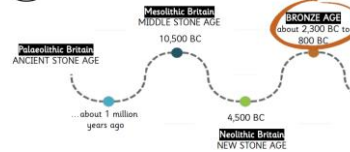


History

I wonder what will be the best method?

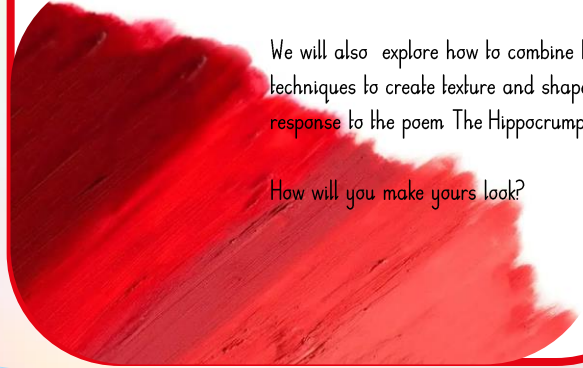
Art and Design
